

REPORT ON GRANTS ALLOCATED

We can advise that since our last Open Board meeting held 15 December 2022, the following grants have been approved by the Invercargill Licensing Trust.

Grey Power Southland

A total grant to a level of **\$7,500** will be provided to assist with Office rent and insurance.

Invercargill Primary School Educational Initiatives Trust

A total grant to a level of **\$21,764** will be provided to assist with Renovations of Enrich Building at 309 Dee Street.
