

REPORT ON GRANTS ALLOCATED

We can advise that since our last Open Board meeting held 15 April 2025, the following grants have been approved by ILT.

Cycling Southland Inc

A total grant to a level of **\$22,500** will be provided to assist with delivery of track cycling and road carnivals through the year.

Invercargill Public Art Trail Charitable Trust

A total grant to a level of **\$5,000** will be provided to assist with a second sculpture in Invercargill's growing art trail.

Royal NZSPCA Inc

A total grant to a level of **\$3,000** will be provided to assist with the purchase of a second-hand tail lift truck for the two RNZSPCA Invercargill Op Shops.

Southland Secondary Schools Sport

A total grant to a level of **\$9,750** will be provided to assist with the salary of the administrator of Secondary School Sports.

Southland Triathlon and Multisport Club Inc

A total grant to a level of **\$7,125** will be provided to assist with events throughout the year.

Te Kahui Manu Titi Charitable Trust

A total grant to a level of **\$5,000** will be provided to assist with Te Reo Rangitahi Programme.
